NOTICE OF PESTICIDE APPLICATIONS AT SCHOOLS

Connecticut Public Act 99-165 requires Old Saybrook Public Schools to adopt a program regarding the application of pesticides at schools and on school grounds. Information regarding this program shall be made annually to all staff and to parents or guardians of students enrolled in the Old Saybrook Public Schools.

Whenever it is deemed necessary to apply a pesticide, it will be done during a period when school is not in session and there are no planned activities on school grounds. All individuals applying pesticides will hold the proper State of Connecticut certificates. Children will not be allowed to enter an area where such application has been made until it is safe to do so according to the provisions on the pesticide label.

Public Act 99-165 also allows for the notification of staff, parents, and guardians of students, prior to application of pesticide. Any individual who wishes to be notified may register to receive notice by completing the bottom portion of this page and returning it to the school.
